Book Review

ISRAEL - God's Covenant People, God's Promised Land - Graham Coates
There is a persistent idea in some parts of the Christian Church that national Israel has been replaced in the plan of God, as if to say that God no longer cares what happens with the modern descendants of the Old Testament people. Pastor Graham Coates insists that such replacement theology is very wide of the truth.

This book is written in three parts. Part 1 sets out the biblical proof that God has not abandoned His covenant with Israel. Part 2, cleverly titled "The Bones are Rattling", is about Israel's homecoming to the land that was promised to the patriarchs. Part 3, titled "Tendons, Flesh and Skin", is about the phenomenal (dare we say miraculous) achievements of the nation of Israel since David Ben Gurion declared independence on 14th May 1948.

The book is well researched, with abundant footnotes. Not until chapter 13 do we read anything that could be considered speculative. Everything else is history, albeit a history that would not please everyone in the United Nations. Pastor Coates affirms the God-given right that Israel has over all of Palestine and all of Jerusalem. And he reminds his readers that the Arab nations surrounding Israel have never accepted Israel's right to even exist at all. On the other hand, Israel has welcomed Arab citizens without discrimination and showed a willingness to compromise for the sake of peace, compromise that has not been reciprocated.

There are many interesting aspects to this book, including a brief but fascinating study on the aleph-tav, an untranslatable combination of letters that seems to point uniquely to Jesus as what we know from the Greek language as Alpha and Omega.

Readers will discover an important and urgent message this book carries for us today.
