#### CAN ONLY IMAGINE - Bart Millard & Robert Nolan

Bart Millard is the founder and main lead singer for Christian band Mercy Me and this book is the story of his difficult childhood and struggles to make it in the Christian music scene. The group now has several award-winning songs to their credit but one song in particular stands out as their breakthrough song. "I Can Only Imagine" may have been the quickest and easiest song that Bart Millard has written but its impact far exceeded his wildest dreams. Not only did the song miraculously cross-over into secular radio, and not only did it attract the attention of the queen of Christian music, Amy Grant, but the song also went on to be featured in a movie of the same name.

This is an outstanding biography, very easy to read but also very inspirational. Readers who are familiar with Mercy Me and their recordings will especially appreciate this book but its message will resonate with anyone. Deeply spiritual, it chronicles the hard times as well as the successes. More than anything, it is a testimony to the faithfulness of God when we choose to do things His way.

The author's father is a key part of this story and, in a way, he was the inspiration for the song. When Bart told Amy Grant that he only took ten minutes to write the song, she replied that, no, in fact it took him a lifetime.

This is a brilliant book that I cannot recommend too highly.
