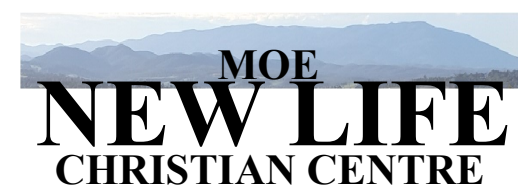

Book Review

TRANSGENDER - One Shade of Grey - Patrick J Byrne (review excerpts)

In recent years, several Western nations have reacted to new theories about gender by accommodating transgender or "non-binary" identities in anti-discrimination laws. But laws that are designed to enshrine and codify the rights of individuals who self-identify in particular ways can also impact other people. This title of this book ... suggests that what was intended as a recognition of diversity becomes, in the end, the very opposite of diversity, whereby all of society is coerced into a sameness of thinking and speaking. The point is well made but a more descriptive title and subtitle for the book would be "Transgenderism - the Legal and Social Consequences".

While clearly making the case for biological identity to take preference in legal matters such as birth certificates, his aim is always to tread a path of compromise that will allow genuine liberty and freedom of expression.

The problem is that transgenderism, as an ideology, seems intent on forcing an undeniably controversial worldview on society as a whole and punishing those who dare to object.

This is a reference work that deserves to be given a hearing whenever debates about gender and sexuality arise.
