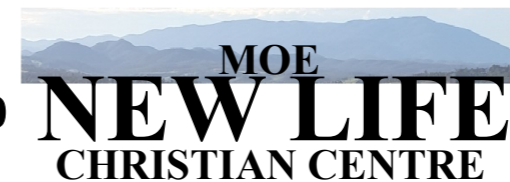

Wow. Here we are already well into the year.

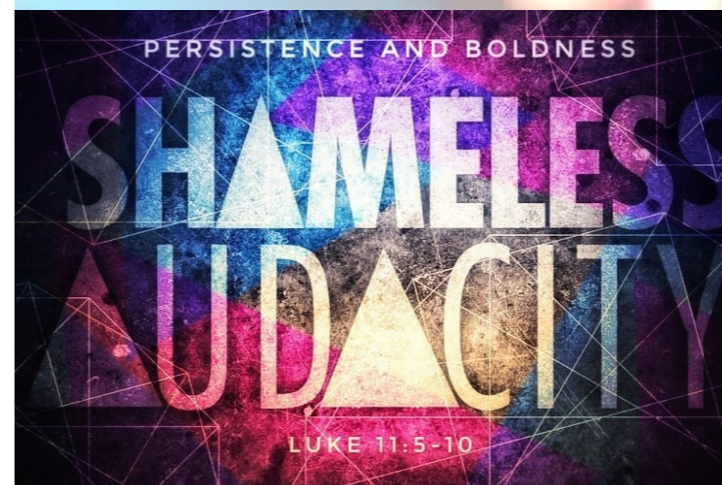

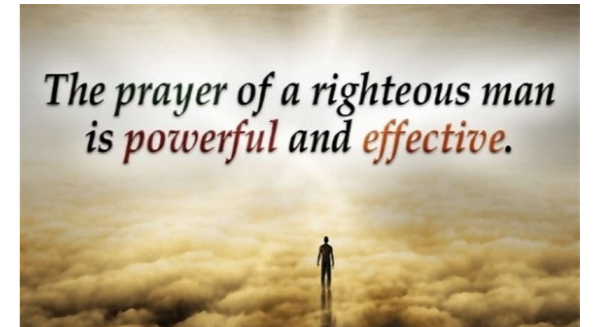
## MISSIONS

The next missions offering is February 16th. All proceeds go to the **Murle Education Foundation Inc.**

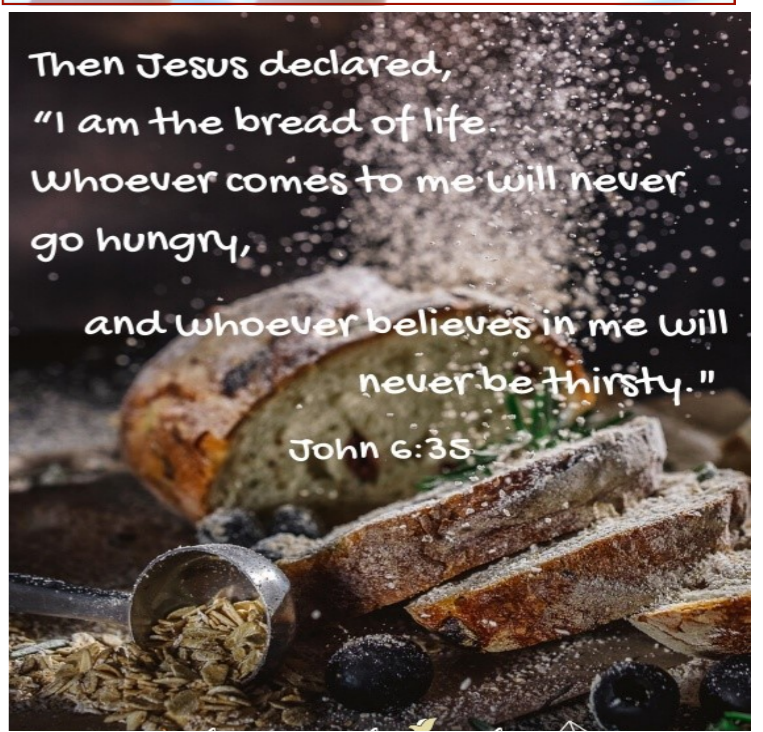

## Book Review

A few church members have picked up *The Popular Encyclopedia of Apologetics* for just \$10, so it's worth a mention. Apologetics is about making a clear and reasonable defence of Christian truth. This book of more than 500 pages covers some 176 topics in a scholarly but readable way.

If you want short, concise articles that explain important theological concepts or introduce you to the famous theologians from church history, or if you want some clues about how to answer the doctrines of cult groups or other religions, this book will be a very handy resource. It also suggests Christian responses to a wide range of modern issues.
