Live streaming? What is it and how can I be a part of it?

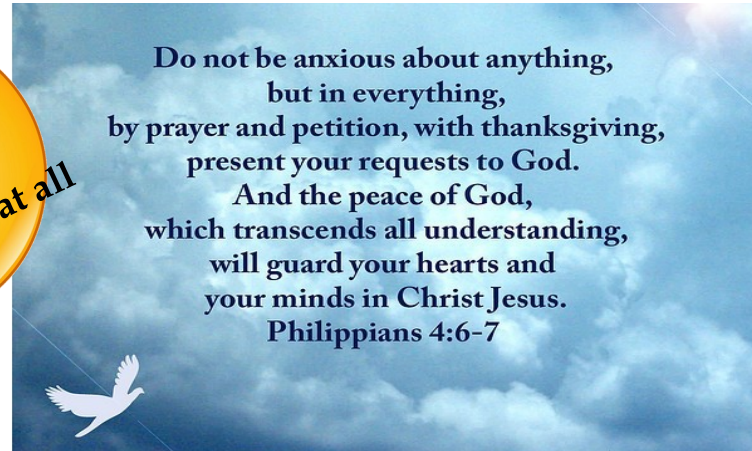
Live streaming is sharing video to a **live** audience through the internet.
