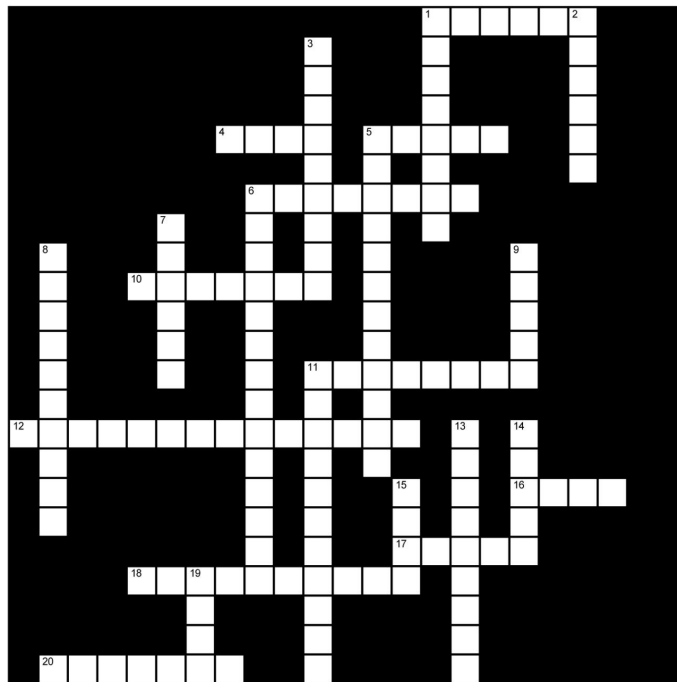

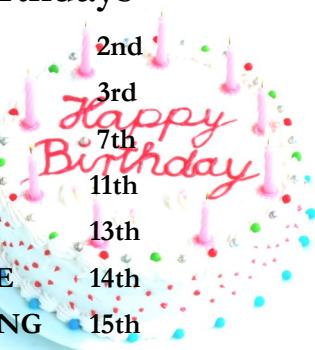
Have a great week, and may the peace of God and joy, strength and power of the Holy Spirit be yours.

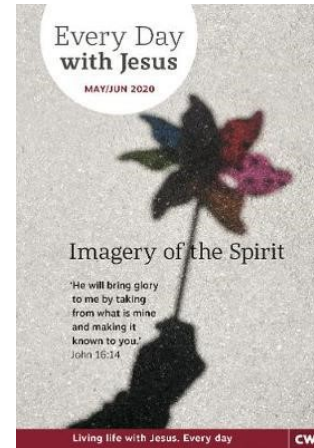
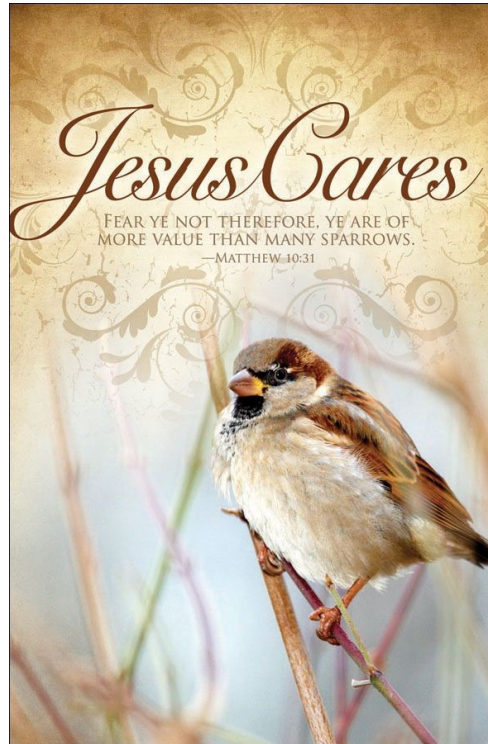

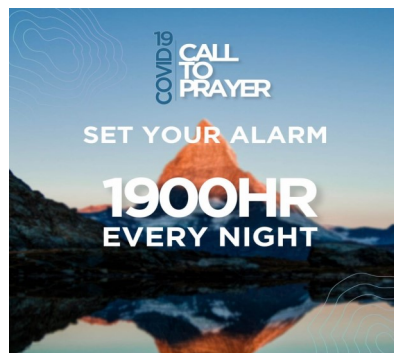
