

So whether we have our tree up yet, or have finished our Christmas shopping, let's keep focused on the real meaning and message of Christmas. We began the year with he message of "keeping our eyes on Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith." And this is how I want to finish the year out - keeping our eyes focused on Jesus. He is the King of Kings, and Lord of Lords. In Australia, we elect a Prime Minister every three years. The gospels of Matthew and Luke both want us to know from the start that Jesus has come as the anointed one. The Christ, the promised King. Not born to nobility, not rich, or powerful. But born to a humble family and raised by a carpenter. He came to establish His kingdom here on earth, not by force, but through love, forgiveness and sacrifice. He calls us to yield our lives to him and offer Him our meagre gifts and talents for His service. Let all that we do honour Jesus, the Messiah, the King, and may we all receive a fresh vision for God's Kingdom coming here on earth as it is in Heaven.

Most of the new arrivals seem incapable of conversation. They just stare at their hands in despair.






